SUPPORT THE ORGANIZATION THAT SUPPORTS YOU

The Brandon Chamber of Commerce acts as a unified voice for businesses of all sizes and interests. Active locally, provincially and nationally, the Chamber does not receive any government funding, making it a truly independent business advocacy organization. This absence of government funding allows the Chamber to advocate solely on the behalf of members and is not subject to influence or opinion.

We are part of the largest, strongest and most influential business network in the country, and collectively we work together advocating to all levels of government to make our community, province and country a better place to live, work and play.

As the voice of business in Brandon, the Chamber of Commerce works with its members on both policy and advocacy to ensure the strongest possible business environment for our members. This means hearing from members on what could be done.

HOW IT WORKS

Issues are identified by Chamber members and member firms, further research is done by Chamber staff, committees and other volunteers, approved by the Board, and then presented to the municipal, provincial, or federal government.

Often times, the Chamber is invited to offer opinion and feedback regarding all types of business issues. From legislation changes and the Workers Compensation Act to pre-budget meetings with provincial and federal Ministers of Finance, Chamber staff and volunteers are on the ground working for the rights of members.

We identify issues relevant to the business community and work with all three levels of government to ensure the economic health, prosperity and quality of life of our community. Our Chamber of Commerce is an active member of both the Manitoba and Canadian Chambers of Commerce and our members benefit from the highly respected advocacy initiatives of both organizations.

Policies are about ideas. Advocacy is about action.
